Please pray for the hill tribe brethren. Many of them are required to stay inside the borders of their small villages yet nearly all of them work outside the village in the fields and if they do not work, they do not get paid. We are thankful that the Lord has provided for many of their needs this month through gifts given by churches and individuals in America. This month the Browns, their children, and my family were able to bag and distribute food and supplies to over 400 families in 18 villages. Several more will be helped throughout the remainder of the month. Praise God for richly supplying their needs! We thank our Lord for the blessing it was to be used to deliver this gift to our brothers and sisters in need!









We are thankful to be able to continue language school in March and April. In mid March, our school closed due to the virus but shortly thereafter the classes were available online. Online classes have surprisingly been really good and we are encouraged by this because that is how we will need to continue with our language studies once we move to Mae Ai. We ended up taking the month of May off from class due to the need of the brethren for food distribution, but Lord willing we will start our language lessons again on June 1st.

Please pray with us about moving to Mai Ai, which is the "base camp" for the work here. Mai Ai is about three hours north of Chiang Mai and is less than 5 miles from the Myanmar border. This is where the land and new ministry building are located. Also, Mai Ai is where our co-laborers, Paul and Susan Brown, live. The ministry building, where Paul and Susan will live, should be finished in another month or two. Once it is complete, the builder is ready to begin work on a staff house for my family. We don't have an estimate yet on what the cost will be to complete the house we will live in but we know we will likely be a little short on funds...please pray with us about this need! Once we are able to start, the builder said she could have the house built and ready to move into within 4-6 months. We are ready to be there!!!
